Visit the **Heage Windmill**, the only working, stone-towered, multi-sailed windmill in England. Set in the Derbyshire countryside, you can climb the tower and see how the flour is milled and view the spectacular scenery towards the Derwent Valley Mills World Heritage Site. Visitors are shown around the mill by guides in period costume. Traditional flour is regularly milled (providing the wind blows) and is sold at the mill shop.
